God can Make a Way where there is no way

Acts 12:5-10 (NKJV)

⁵ Peter was therefore kept in prison, but constant prayer was offered to God for him by the church. ⁶ And when Herod was about to bring him out, that night Peter was sleeping, bound with two chains between two soldiers; and the guards before the door were keeping the prison. ⁷ Now behold, an angel of the Lord stood by him, and a light shone in the prison; and he struck Peter on the side and raised him up, saying, "Arise quickly!" And his chains fell off his hands. ⁸ Then the angel said to him, "Gird yourself and tie on your sandals"; and so he did. And he said to him, "Put on your garment and follow me." ⁹ So he went out and followed him, and did not know that what was done by the angel was real, but thought he was seeing a vision. ¹⁰ When they were past the first and the second guard posts, they came to the iron gate that leads to the city, which opened to them of its own accord; and they went out and went down one street, and immediately the angel departed from him.

- 1. When there is nothing we can do, just pray (v.5)
 - ⁵ Peter was therefore kept in prison, but constant prayer was offered to God for him by the church.
 - While Peter was kept in prison, the brothers and sisters were praying for him
 - There was nothing else that they could do, so they decide to pray
- 2. Having confidence that God is in control, just go to sleep (v.6a)
 - 6 And when Herod was about to bring him out, that night Peter was sleeping...
 - Before the judgment, Peter was sleeping because the church was praying for him
 - When we pray together, we overcome any circumstance
- 3. Waiting for God's guidance, at the right time His Light will shine (v.7)

⁷ Now behold, an angel of the Lord stood by him, and a light shone in the prison; and he struck Peter on the side and raised him up, saying, "Arise quickly!" And his chains fell off his hands.

- When the angel found Peter, he gave him instructions and direction
- By the sound of his voice, the handcuffs fell down and the gates have been open

8 Then the angel said to him, "Gird yourself and tie on your sandals"; and so he did. And he said to him, "Put on your garment and follow me."
